The CETA Middle Stage Fest, now in its sixteenth year, is an exciting event for middle school drama students. At the festival, students perform monologues and scenes for panels of adjudicators and compete to earn bronze, silver and gold medals. In addition, while judges are tabulating the scores, students get to participate in high-energy theatre games.

Unlike involvement in sports, it is rare for theatre students to have the opportunity to meet peers from other schools, share their passion, showcase their talent, and learn from one another. This festival brings together hundreds of students to do just that. All participating students qualify to attend CA YOUTH IN THEATRE DAY, where they meet and perform with other award-winning students from throughout the state.

Your Day at the Festival

Students may compete in up to two of four categories. Students will perform each of their events three times – twice in the morning, will perform each of their events twice – once and once after lunch. A boxed lunch is provided for all participants.

In the first session, tire judges offer verbal feedback to the students, much like in a master class. In the second and third sessions, the students perform again for a new panel of judges who will score their performances. While scores are being tabulated students participate in high-energy theatre activities.

5 minutes maximum
Two chairs will be provided.

3 minutes maximum
One chair will be provided.*

Musical Duets
(2 person scenes)
5 minutes maximum
Two chairs will be provided.*

Performances in all six categories are conducted under **audition conditions**. No costumes or sets. If required by scene, small hand props are acceptable.

*Students may perform A Cappella. Also a CD player and speakers for use with phones/ipods will be provided.
