Fees

Registration is \$35.00 per student, which includes cheese pizza lunch. There is no fee for the Theatre Teacher / Troupe Director, \$15.00 Fee for Extra Chaperones.

Individual Events

Students may participate in Individual Events for a \$5 Fee in Acting, Musical, and select Tech opportunities. Student's adjudication will follow the National Middle School Standards, Rubrics and Resources can be found on the Event Website.

OVERVIEW OF

Individual Events

Each student is invited to bring one Individual Event to the Junior Thespian Festival. Students will be performing for 1-2 judges, and feedback will be given on the official Jr. Thespian Share Sheet, which students and teachers can use for growth. You can find these rubrics online on our event website. All students who receive a Superior ranking will receive a Superior Medal at the I.E. Showcase, and the top I.E.s will be invited to perform in the I.E. Showcase at the end of the day.

No costumes or props allowed. 3 minute MAXIMUM in ALL performance categories. All students should follow the proper slate (see "How-To Slate" resource).

Monologue - One (1) monologue from a PUBLISHED play (no original, stand alone, or film), with a 3-minute MAXIMUM.

Duet Acting - (2 people)- must be from a PUBLISHED play (no original, stand alone, or film), with a 3-minute MAXIMUM.

Solo Musical - One (1) song from a MUSICAL (no film, or pop/rock music). Must bring own speakers and MP3 player/phone.

Duet Musical – (2 people) One (1) song from a MUSICAL (no film, or pop/rock music). Must bring own speakers and MP3 player/phone.

Set Design - create a design for a play or musical by bringing in EITHER a color rendering or a model. In addition, write paragraph explaining your design. You will be asked questions during your presentation such as: Why did you choose this play to design? Or What do you think would be the biggest challenge in implementing this design?

Costume Design - create three (3) color renderings of three (3) different characters from the same play or musical. In addition, write paragraph explaining your design. You will be asked questions during your presentation such as: Why did you choose this play to design? Or What do you think would be the biggest challenge in implementing this design?

Theatre Marketing/Publicity - create a 11x17 poster that advertises a production of a play or musical. It should include the school that is performing the show, the dates, the time, and the cost of the tickets. In addition, write paragraph explaining your design. You will be asked questions during your presentation such as: Why did you choose this play to design? Or What do you think would be the biggest challenge in implementing this design?
