Membership Requirements/Benefits

Membership extends from Fall General Meeting to the day before the next Fall General Meeting.

For the term of year paid membership the following offers will be available:

- An associate company representative may make a brief 3 minute presentation to DTASC members at the Fall and Winter annual meetings for approximately 120 middle/high school theatre educators.
- An associate member who attends the Fall General meeting may bring 100 brochures or mail them to the DTASC membership secretary, who will display them at the meeting. Email the membership secretary to arrange this.
- An associate company's name, logo and website will be displayed on a page of Associate Members on the DTASC website. The company may add a couple of lines explaining their mission or value to DTASC members.
- For a fee of \$50 per season (Fall/Spring), an associate company may set up a table at all DTASC student festivals throughout the academic year and distribute information to participating students.
